

# Dues Structure

## International Labor Communications Association

### Dues for 2011 Membership

Dues are for a calendar year. Members may elect to pay dues in semi-annual installments, due January 1 and July 1, if they so notify the Secretary-Treasurer when making their first payment. Dues for publications are based on circulation, using post office statements if available, or on dues-paying membership, whichever is less. A copy of the publication's postal statement must be submitted with the annual membership application.

#### **Labor Federations**

For publications of the AFL-CIO, CTW, the CLC, and headquarters or constitutional departments of the AFL-CIO, CTW and the CLC, dues are:

<u>Category</u>	<u>Dues Rate</u>
2A	\$5.00 per thousand circulation, with a minimum of \$500 for the first publication
2B	Each additional publication shall pay dues at the rate of \$5.00 per thousand circulation, with a minimum of \$300 per publication

#### **National and International Unions**

For publications of national or international unions, dues are:

<u>Category</u>	<u>Dues Rate</u>
3A	Circulations of less than 20,000, \$300 per year.
3B	Circulations of 20,000 or more, \$5.00 per thousand, with a minimum of \$500 per year.
3C	National or international unions which affiliate more than one print publication shall pay the applicable minimum for the largest publication. For each additional publication, dues shall be at the effective per-thousand rate, but not less than \$300
3D	Select-circulation newsletters of national and international unions and headquarters departments of the AFL-CIO, CTW and CLC: \$250

#### **State, Local and Other Labor Organizations**

For publications of, or endorsed by, state, area or central bodies; inter-union councils; local unions; and other subordinate bodies of national and international unions, dues are:

<u>Category</u>	<u>Dues Rate</u>
4A	Less than 500 circulation: \$55
4B	500-1,000 circulation: \$85
4C	1,001-5,000 circulation: \$125
4D	5,001-10,000 circulation: \$175
4E	10,001-20,000 circulation: \$250
4F	20,001-30,000 circulation: \$300
4G	30,001-50,000 circulation: \$350
4H	More than 50,000 circulation: \$5 per thousand, minimum of \$400

### **In-House Departments**

For in-house departments of labor organizations affiliated with the AFL-CIO, CTW and/or CLC which produce no publications or regularly scheduled media productions otherwise eligible for membership, but have on-going responsibilities for media relations and media projects; in-house union positions that produce no regular publications or scheduled media productions but are responsible for organizing, publicity, speech-writing, training, or similar promotional and/or outreach efforts on behalf of the union, dues are:

<u>Category</u>	<u>Dues Rate</u>
5	\$250

### **Broadcast Publications**

For regularly scheduled broadcast, video and similar media productions, dues are:

<u>Category</u>	<u>Dues Rate</u>
6A	For national and international unions and AFL-CIO/ CTW/CLC constitutional departments: \$275
6B	For all others: \$150

### **Associations**

For associations affiliated with ILCA, dues are:

<u>Category</u>	<u>Dues Rate</u>
7	\$2.00 per member, with a minimum of \$225

### **Websites and Other Electronic Publications**

For Web sites, listserves, email communities and other such electronic publications, dues are:

- For electronic publications controlled by the AFL-CIO, CTW, the CLC or their constitutional departments; or by national and international unions:

<u>Category</u>	<u>Dues Rate</u>
8A	\$300 for organizations that affiliate an electronic publication and a print publication. (Dues for the print publication will be based on the terms of Category 3)

Organizations that affiliate only their electronic publication pay the following dues:

<u>Category</u>	<u>Dues Rate</u>
8B	Membership of less than 100,000, \$500 per year
8C	Membership of 100,001 to 300,000, \$750 per year
8D	Membership of 300,001 to 500,000, \$1,000 per year
8E	Membership of 500,001 to 750,000, \$1,500 per year
8F	Membership of more than 750,000, \$2,000 per year

- For electronic publications controlled by state, area or central bodies; inter-union councils; local unions; and other subordinate bodies of national and international unions:

<u>Category</u>	<u>Dues Rate</u>
8G	\$100 for organizations that affiliate an electronic publication and a print publication. (Dues for the print publication will be based on the terms of Category 4)

### **Websites and Other Electronic Publications (continued)**

Organizations that affiliate only their electronic publication pay the following dues:

<u>Category</u>	<u>Dues Rate</u>
8H	Membership or affiliation of less than 1,000: \$75
8I	Membership or affiliation of 1,001-5,000: \$100
8J	Membership or affiliation of 5,001-10,000: \$125
8K	Membership or affiliation of 10,001-20,000: \$150
8L	Membership or affiliation of 20,001-50,000: \$200
8M	Membership or affiliation of more than 50,000: \$250

### **Retiree Publications**

<u>Category</u>	<u>Dues Rate</u>
9	For print, broadcast, and electronic retiree publications of, or endorsed by, state, area or central bodies; inter-union councils; local unions; and other subordinate bodies of national and international unions, full membership dues shall be 50 percent of the regular dues rate as listed in Section 4, Section 6 or Section 8, whichever is applicable for the retiree publication.

### **ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIPS**

<u>Category</u>	<u>Dues Rate</u>
10A	Associate member/sponsor, \$1,000 per year
10B	Associate member/organization, \$300 per year
10C	Associate member/individual, \$50 per year
10D	Associate member/student publication, \$50 per year
10E	Associate member/individual student, \$10 per year

### **DUES DISCOUNTS**

- Local union publications that are also members in good standing of a state, regional or industrial labor press association affiliated with ILCA may receive a credit against their ILCA dues equal to the dues of the affiliated association. This credit, of up to \$25 per year, is limited to local union publications with circulation of less than 10,000. No publication can receive more than one such credit annually, except that qualifying publications can also receive an additional \$10 credit if they are members in good standing of CALM/acps.
- Publications of international unions that are members in good standing of CALM/acps, and do not have a separate Canadian edition, may receive a credit on their ILCA dues for that portion of their circulation which reflects Canadian distribution.
- Local union publications and/or media productions that are members in good standing of CALM/acps may receive a credit of \$10 a year against their dues to ILCA.
- These discounts will be refunded once the ILCA processes the publication's annual dues payment and verifies membership in the other labor press association.
